- 1. We hereby give notice of the intent of the NATO C & I Agency (NCI Agency), to issue an Invitation For Bids (IFB) for the provision of Consultancy Framework for Modernisation and Rationalisation of NATO Technology Infrastructure.
- 2. A summary of the requirements of the project is set forth in Annex A, attached to this letter.
- 3. The reference for the Invitation For Bid is **IFB-CO-13887-IT**, and all correspondence concerning the IFB should reference this number.
- 4. The IT Modernisation (ITM) Consultancy Contract is required to provide consultancy support to NCI Agency to implement the ITM Project, and its adoption within the NATO Enterprise.

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- 5. The ITM Project is to be implemented to over 44 sites and over 4 Waves. Wave 1 is estimated to last 1.5 years, with the following subsequent Waves estimated to be of 1 year durations.
- 6. The work is divided into three parts:
  - a. A Technical Advisor who provides expert advice in the design and implementation of cloud based technology and service based IT management and support over the duration of the ITM Project.
  - b. Defined Tasks which are to be fulfilled by the Contractor.
  - c. A framework for additional Task Orders, which are expected to emerge during the ITM implementation. Work in this area will be subject to further authorizations. The Contract scope will cover the full 4 Waves duration.
- 7. For the purpose of planning it is estimated that the initial budget for consultancy under this contract will be around 3.3 M Euro in the first Wave.
- 8. The NCI Agency is authorised to use the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) Procedure, lowest price compliant bid. The successful bid, pursuant to the IFB following this NOI, will be that bid which is the lowest price and technically compliant in accordance with the evaluation criteria prescribed in the IFB.
- 9. Bidders should be aware that the successful Bidder for this requirement will be excluded from future work supporting the implementation of the following ITM Work Packages: related to the scope of the consultancy. It is planned that the exclusion will apply for a period of three years after end of the Contract.
  - WP1 Systems Integrator and Implementation of Back-end Services.
  - WP2 Establish a Framework Contract for the Client Devices
  - WP4 Expansion of New NATO HQ Datacentre for the Enterprise
  - WP6 Modification to the NCIRC FOC infrastructure
- 10. The IFB release is planned to be issued in December 2014, with a Bid Closing Date in February 2015 and Contract Award in April/May 2015.
- 11. Pursuant to paragraph 5 of reference (A), National Responsible Authorities are kindly requested that the NCI Agency be provided with Declarations of Eligibility, not later than 8 December 2014, of qualified and certified firms which may be interested in receiving an Invitation for Bid for this project. The Declarations of Eligibility should include the following information: Name of the Firm, Telephone number, Fax number, E-mail address and Point of Contact within each of the nominated firms. This information is critical to enable prompt and accurate communication with prospective bidders and should be sent to the following address:

- 12. Bidders will be required to declare a bid validity of twelve (12) months from closing date for receipt of bids, supported by a Bid Guarantee of Euro 50,000 insert (fifty thousand Euro). Should the selection and award procedure exceed the Bid Closing Date by more than six months firms will be requested to voluntarily extend the validity of their bids and Bid Guarantee accordingly. Bidders may decline to do so, withdraw their bid and excuse themselves from the bidding process without penalty.
- 13. National authorities are advised that the IFB package will be NATO UNCLASSIFIED.
- 14. It is emphasised that requests for participation in this competition received directly from individual firms cannot be considered.

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#### ANNEX A - SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS

### **Consulting Support**

## 1. Description of Project Background

- 1.1.The IT Modernisation (ITM) Consultancy Contract is required to provide consultancy support to NCI Agency to implement the ITM Project, and its adoption within the NATO Enterprise.
- 1.2. The IT Modernisation endeavour will implement a NATO Enterprise wide IT capability to support the provisioning of IT Services to NATO Enterprise customers. The NCI Agency aims to achieve efficiency gains and increase the IT services effectiveness by the rationalisation and consolidation of the IT assets and management capability, and by standardized services provisioning.
- 1.3. As part of IT Modernisation the NCI Agency will replace obsolescent equipment with modern and standardized technology throughout the NATO enterprise and standardize the lifecycle management of the IT assets.
- 1.4. The ITM Project is to be implemented to over 44 sites and over 4 Waves. Wave one is estimated to last 1.5 years, with the following subsequent Waves estimated to be of 1 year durations.

#### 2. Statement of Objectives

#### 2.1. Corporate Objective

a. The overall objective is to provide timely and easy access to consulting services needed to support the design and implementation of NCI Agency ITM Project and its adoption within the NCI Agency and the wider NATO Enterprise.

#### 3. Description of Project Scope

- 3.1. The work to be undertaken by the Contractor is divided into three parts:
  - A Technical Advisor who provides expert advice in the implementation of cloud based technology and service based IT management and support over the duration of the ITM Project.
  - b. Defined Tasks with deliverables to provide Joining Instructions, a model Service Level Agreement (SLA) and a draft SLA for Infrastructure as a Service and a Costing Model for future services.

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- c. A framework for additional Task Orders which are expected to emerge over the duration of ITM implementation (some of the work in this area will be subject to further authorisations).
- 3.2. Additional tasks have not been defined at this stage but the following are under consideration:
  - Support to Design Reviews
  - laaS functional testing
  - ITM laaS Roadmap.
  - Migration Plan Reviews
  - Support to TBCE development for ITM Wave 2
